

## 'hana' / 'hikari' acrylic bath



the design of the acrylic japanese baths is based on the traditional shape and proportions of the domestic bath in japan.

'hana'  
the volume is 265 litres / 70 gallons to the rim and its outside dimensions are 1220mm long x 820mm wide x 540mm deep or 48" x 32 1/4" x 21 1/4" deep.

'hikari'  
the volume is 300 litres / 75 gallons to the rim and its outside dimensions are 1330mm long x 830mm wide x 540mm deep, or 52 3/8" long x 32 11/16" wide x 21 1/4" deep. manufactured from mitsubishi acrylic in australia, the rim is strengthened with steel, one end slopes as a back rest and there is a ledge and a lip on all sides.

the specifications may vary slightly.

## 'koharu' polyester bath



the polyester japanese bath is the same volume as the acrylic bath but the production technique enables the proportions to be closer to the traditional japanese bath.

'koharu'  
the 'koharu' polyester bath is 1220mm long x 770mm wide x 570mm deep, or 48" long x 30 5/16" wide x 22 7/16" deep. carefully handcrafted, the rim is strengthened with steel, one end slopes as a back rest and there is a ledge and a lip on all sides.

the specifications may vary slightly.

## wooden baths

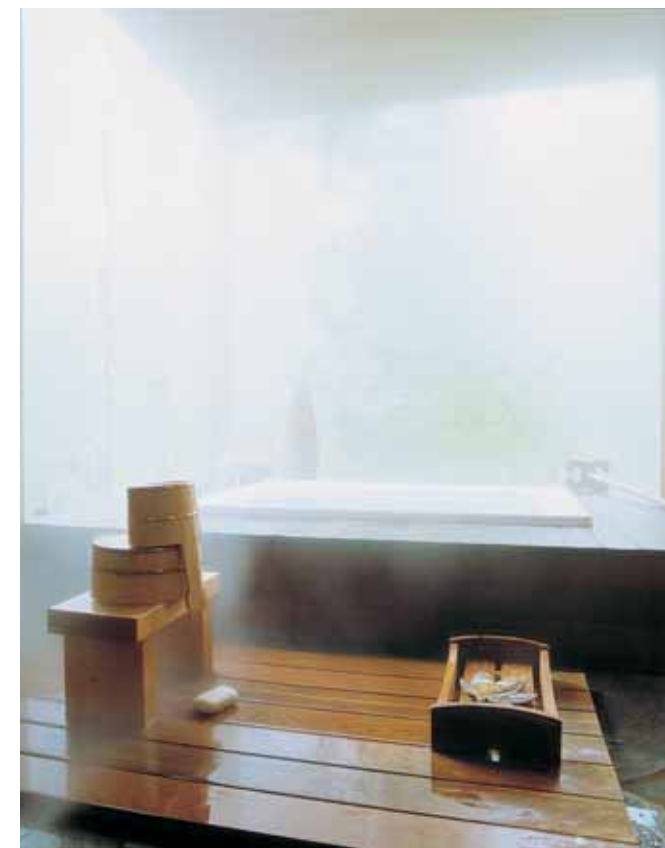


'hinoki'

the wooden japanese baths are custom-made by craftsmen to a maximum 1.5m / 5ft long and available in w. r. cedar (made in australia) or the traditional 'hinoki' (delivered direct from japan). they should be kept moist inside, lightly oiled and cleaned regularly to prolong their long life. additional information is available on care, maintenance, design, installation and the optional accessories.
